

# Enabling Real Time Integration (RTI) in v10x – Quick Guide

---

## Overview

CMiC Real Time Integration (RTI) allows for the bi-directional updating of databases via XML standards. CMiC RTI flows data entered into the general contractor's system to the owner's system by internet and XML protocols, allowing for different systems to seamlessly communicate. This quick guide provides steps for enabling RTI in v10x.

## Procedure

Complete the following steps to enable RTI in v10x:

1. Take a backup of opmn.xml under MIDTIERJSP\_HOME\asinst\_midt tierjsp\config\OPMN\opmn.
2. Edit opmn.xml and find entry line <process-type id="CMICRTI\_ENV" module-id="CUSTOM" status="disabled">.
3. Change line to <process-type id="CMICRTI\_enabled" module-id="CUSTOM" status="enabled">.
4. Restart the OPMN on that Oracle Home.

**NOTE:** This process only needs to be done on 1 JSP server and only 1 JSP server for that environment.
